GENERAL ORDER

It is the Order of this Court that Local Criminal Rule 12.1H is hereby vacated in its entirety and replaced by the following:

H. Discovery in Criminal Cases. Under Rule 16 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, it is expected the parties will complete discovery themselves, and the necessity of filing discovery motions is eliminated except when disputes arise. Discovery orders are hereby eliminated except when irreconcilable disputes arise. The court shall not hear any such motion unless counsel for the movant certifies in writing to the court that the opposing attorneys have conferred in good faith and have been unable to resolve the dispute. Defense counsel shall not transfer possession of, disseminate, reproduce, or copy any grand jury, law enforcement, or other documentary materials disclosed by the United States Attorney's Office pursuant to this Local Rule, the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure, federal statute, or federal case law authority, and shall be responsible for maintaining complete custody and control over the materials. This prohibition applies unless otherwise ordered by the court, after the government having been provided notice and an opportunity to be heard. Upon written request of the United States Attorney's Office, all documentary materials provided to defense counsel shall be returned to the United States Attorney's Office no later than one year from the expiration of the last appellate deadline.




